### August Principal Report –

- Education Week started today and the Book Fair has been set up in the hall. Open Day and Book Parade will take place tomorrow. Open classrooms will be from 10:00am and performances to begin at 10:40am. The book fair will be open at lunchtime on Tuesday, and from 2:45 – 3:15pm on Tuesday and Wednesday.
- Preschool Visit – 22 students from Pappa Bear preschool visited Kindergarten last week. The aim of the visit is to continue to build connections with local preschools and assist with Kindy transition.
- Music tutorials have begun again for Term 3 with 27 students taking up the option to learn either the guitar or keyboard.
- We celebrated NAIDOC Week in the first week back by participating in some indigenous games. ☑ Mrs McNally and Kindergarten celebrated 100 Days of Kindergarten in Week 1.
- Noisewall update – Grass has been laid and is being watered. Fence to be taken down in 3 weeks after the grass is more established. Chicken coop has been installed and garden beds are filled with soil and in place. Graffiti on the wall has been removed additional plants are also to be planted. A temporary CCTV camera has been installed to monitor the wall. We are currently looking at some mural ideas for the school side of the wall. Concern about having a plain wall for an extended period may encourage graffiti in the school side.
- SRC – has purchased a compost bin to install in the garden area. This area will soon be our environmental space – chickens, composting, garden and recycling.
- We are currently a collection point Lids 4 Kids. The caps will go to Envision—an Australian, not for profit group that trains disadvantaged people to use 3D printers to make mobility aids for child amputees.
- K-6 Science incursion this Thursday. The topic is “Destination Moon” and students will participate in 2 STEM challenges by constructing rockets and lunar landers.
